

If you're working or training and earn below these levels, you might be entitled to a Childcare Subsidy for pre-schoolers for up to 50 hours a week, or an OSCAR (Out of School Care and Recreation) Subsidy for children under 14 for up to 20 hours a week during term time and 50 hours a week during school holidays.

If you're already receiving childcare assistance, your entitlement has been automatically adjusted. And you don't need to contact us.
